General Rules:

1. All contestants must be ages 5-18 years of age as of June 21, 2009. Age is determined as of June 21, 2009.
2. All contestants must reside in Lorain County for the past six (6) months. If necessary, families will be required to show proof of residency or school final report card.
3. All contestants must submit a \$10.00 entry fee with application and a picture by June 07, 2009. Late entries will only be accepted until June 14, 2009 and contestant must then submit a \$15.00 entry fee with application and picture.
4. **NO ENTRIES OR PICTURES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER JUNE 14, 2009!**
5. Make checks or money orders payable to The Miss Liberty Pageant. Do not send cash. There will be a \$20.00 charge for returned checks. Mail entries and fee to The Miss Liberty Pageant, PO Box 1004, Columbia Station, Ohio 44028. **FEES ARE NON-REFUNDABLE UNLESS THE PAGEANT IS COMPLETELY CANCELLED.** We are not responsible for lost or misdirected mail.
6. Rehearsal for Miss Liberty Pageant will be on Tuesday June 16, 2009 from 6:30-8:30 p.m. at the Columbia VFW Post 9340.
7. ALL Division Queens and 1st Attendants will receive CROWN, TROPHY & BANNER!
8. ALL Queens will receive \$100.00 Savings bond, 1st Attendant will receive \$50.00 Savings bond. Winners are required to provide their social security number to receive their savings bond upon completion of their reign and fulfillment of Policy and Procedure requirements. They are required to be at the crowning of the 2010 pageant.
9. ALL divisions will have a Photogenic Award. Contestants must submit one (1) picture no larger than 5"x7". Photogenic winner will be chosen from the picture submitted with application only. Pictures submitted at a later date will not be entered. Photos will NOT be returned and become property of the Columbia Chamber of Commerce, and Miss Liberty Pageant.
10. Miss Liberty Princess & Miss Liberty will have a Community Service Award. (Girl Scouts, 4-H, Key Club, Historical Society, Columbia Homecoming Volunteer, Library Volunteer, Hospital Volunteer, and etc).
11. The winner of each age group is ineligible to compete the following year. She will return to crown her successor. A contestant may hold a title only once per age group.
12. The Miss Liberty Pageant and the Pageant Director reserves the right to merge age groups, if necessary.
13. Parents are NOT allowed to participate with contestant in any way while they are on stage.
14. Proper interview dress or suit is required.
15. Interviews will be held at the Columbia Townhall-25496 Royalton Rd. (Rt. 82), Columbia Station, Ohio 44028.
16. Interviews will be every 10 minutes starting at 2:00 p.m. Contestant will be given interview time at rehearsals on Tuesday. Please arrive no later than 5 minutes before your scheduled interview time.

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17. Pageant will be held at the Columbia VFW Post 9340-25742 Royalton Rd. (Rt. 82), Columbia Station, Ohio, 44028. Pageant will start at 7:00 p.m.
18. All contestants are encouraged to attend the Queens dinner at their expense. A parent or guardian must accompany contestant at their expense.
19. All contestants are encouraged to participate in the Grand Parade on Sunday June 28, 2009 at 4:30 p.m, but must provide their own transportation and sign. Parade entry form must be completed and returned to Pageant Director by 6/24/09.
20. The decision of the judges is final.
21. Winners are to remain on stage for pictures!

Columbia Homecoming Festival Royalty Policies & Procedures

1. All Royalty Court members and their families shall abide by the rules set fourth by the Columbia Chamber of Commerce, Miss Liberty Pageant, Pageant Director and Columbia Homecoming Committee.
2. The Miss Liberty Pageant and Pageant Director are responsible for any and all decisions regarding the court and court members. All communications and directions will be conducted through the Pageant Director. This includes, but is not limited to events, parades, luncheon reservations and festival invites. Any correspondence or invitations received by the court are to be forwarded to the Pageant Director.
3. Royalty members shall be accompanied by, a Miss Liberty Pageant Representative, parent or guardian at all appearances. Parents or guardians are responsible for the safety and behavior of their child at all times.
4. Royalty members and their family shall treat all people with respect that they come in contact during their representation of the community festival and the chamber. The royalty title is a privilege and honor, and court member must display appropriate behavior.
5. Royalty Court members shall dress accordingly when representing the Columbia Chamber of Commerce and Miss Liberty Pageant at any and all functions. The following dress code is to be followed:
 - Sash and crown are to be worn at all times.
 - At no time shall the wording on the sashes be covered.
 - No visible tattoos or body piercing.
 - No cleavage or mid-drift exposure.
 - No mini skirts, dresses or skirts should be any shorter than 3 inches above the knee.
 - No jeans unless permitted to do so by the Pageant Director for special events.
 - No flip-flops or tennis shoes may be worn, unless permitted to do so by the Pageant Director for special events.
 - Final approval of wardrobe worn is solely at the discretion of the Pageant Director. If wardrobe is seen as unfit the royalty member will NOT be allowed to participate in the event until they have changed.
 - Formal Wear is to be worn to all luncheons and parades, unless Pageant Director instructs court member otherwise.

6. Royalty members are responsible for attending a minimum of (10) fairs, festivals and events throughout their reign, in addition to the following local events. (Exception: The Miss Liberty Sweetheart division is only required to attend (2) fairs, festivals and events throughout their reign. A parent or guardian must also accompany them). Note that ALL court members are required to attend all Columbia Township functions listed below;

- Mother's Day Pancake Breakfast
- Memorial Day Parade
- Antique Engine Show (1st weekend in June)
- Columbia Homecoming Festival, Queens Dinner & Parade (Last weekend in June)
- "Festival of Trees"
- Events or Activities that are deemed necessary by the Chamber Board of Directors or Pageant Director.
- Helping in queen's booth at the Columbia Homecoming & Engine Show.

7. The Miss Liberty Pageant will pay for the main court's luncheon when visiting other festivals. If the first attendants choose to participate in the luncheon, they will be responsible for the cost of the luncheon (unless they are replacing the Queen of their division at an event. Parents and guardians are responsible for the cost of their own luncheon.

8. Punctuality is expected at all times. This is common respect for the court and their family.

9. During the contestants reign, no inner-court member shall be a member of any other royalty court, with the exception their High School Homecoming, Prom court, County Fair or Fundraiser Pageants.

10. The Columbia Chamber of Commerce shall be financially responsible for maintaining the float or vehicle used in parades. All changes made to the float or vehicle must be finalized and authorized by the Pageant Director.

11. The crown awarded to the court members is the crown that will be worn at all parades, festivals and events. No court member is to purchase a different crown to wear in place of the awarded crown. The crown is the property of the Columbia Chamber of Commerce and will be awarded to the Queens and 1st Attendants at the successful completion of their reign. If a crown is lost, stolen or damaged it is the responsibility of the court member to replace it with the same crown or get it fixed. So make sure to take good care of it.

12. Any trophies or monetary donations awarded to the royalty shall immediately become the property of the Miss Liberty Pageant and be included in the Miss Liberty budget.

13. At the conclusion of Royalty Court's term, all court members, parents and guardians are responsible for the following:

- Planning and hosting the Columbia Homecoming Festival Queen's Dinner.
- Collection of gift bag items for Queens Dinner.
- Purchase or obtain donations of (3) door prizes for the dinner.
- Designing the Festival pins to be provided to the visiting royalty and court members.
- Help setup and decorate for Queens Dinner and clean up after dinner.
- Work at the queen's booth during parade. (Out going Queens and 1st Attendants).
- Collect items for Chinese auction.

14. Boyfriends shall not be allowed on the float, vehicle or walk in parades with the court during their public appearances. They may however, be present at these events. Public display of affection with a boyfriend is forbidden during member's public appearances.

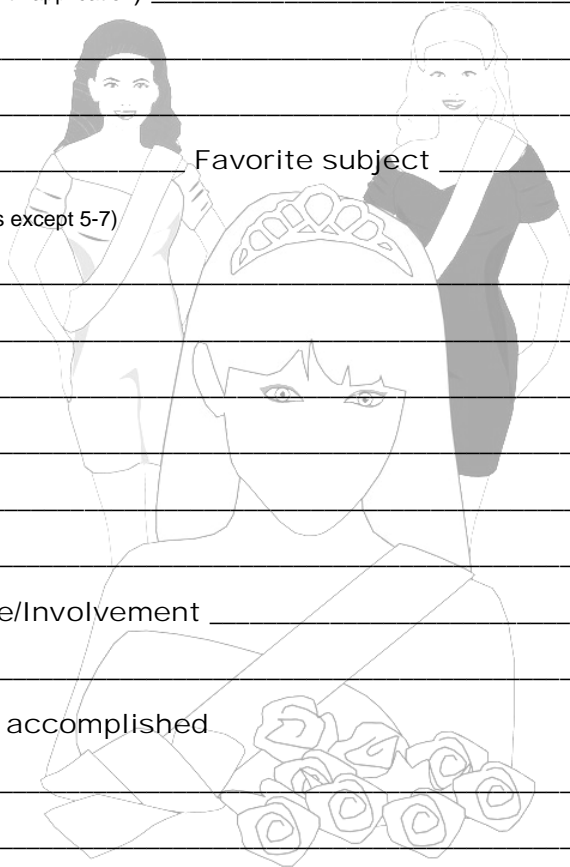
